

PARENTAL CIRCULAR REGARDING LATE REPORTING & UNIFORM CODE

Dear Parent,

As you have already acknowledged the Late Comer Stamp Code in the school Almanac, we hope the late coming issue will be tackled and the school kids will understand the value of being disciplined.

Late Comer Stamp Code: For Class IX-XII we have defined separate code for late coming students.

From this academic session onwards students studying in class IX to XII have been exempted from the stamp system. Students will no longer be allowed to enter the school premises even if they are 2 minutes late and the school gates have closed. We will not encourage parents arguing at the school gate regarding this.

For Class I to VIII the Late Comer stamp is in vogue this year too. Students will be allowed to enter the school premises only twice in a month after the school gates have closed. A late comer stamp will be put in their diary. After 3 such stamps in your ward's school diary (almanac) he/she will be denied entry to the school (in case he/she is late for the fourth time). Argument at the school gate by parents shall not be encouraged at any cost. Discipline is the core of a school functioning system and we expect students to abide by the rules laid down by the school. We also appreciate parents who are the motivating factor behind such kids.

Note: The new School House Uniform (Track Suit) for classes I to XI will be available from 12th April, 2018 (Thursday) onwards. You are requested to purchase the house uniform within a week. No student will be allowed to enter the school premises after 20th April, 2018(Friday). Only House Uniform will be made available in the above mentioned dates.

Second Saturday & Sunday Timings: 10.00 am to 2.00 pm.
